## Hazardous Waste Permit Modification Requested

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume IV. This modification details operations at the F-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facility (HWMF).

The revisions (Rev. 12 of Volume IV) add injection well FIN-10 to the F-Area injection well network and adds redevelopment of injection/ extraction wells as an approved routine maintenance activity.

This notice begins a 60-day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room

located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittees' compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 18, 3 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
