

ONENNSAccess | Savannah River Site Access Instructions

Access Overview

If you have a valid HSPD-12 badge from the Department of Energy (DOE), you are encouraged to use the OneNNSAccess (ONA) portal to pre-register your badge and request area access three to five days before your visit to the Savannah River Site.

Unlike some other DOE sites, you can enter the general barricade at SRS with a visual inspection of your badge by the protective force; advance registration is not required for this initial access. At SRS, registration through ONA currently only provides access to a limited number of security areas. If you are unsure whether ONA will benefit you, contact your host for confirmation and to ensure you request access to the appropriate location. In order to ensure that access approvals are routed correctly and in a timely manner, please reach out to your host to confirm the host/contact name and spelling that should be used during the registration process.

If you choose to pre-register and your registration is approved, you do not need to visit the badge office upon arrival. Your HSPD-12 badge will remain active for authorized access at SRS until the end of your approved visit.

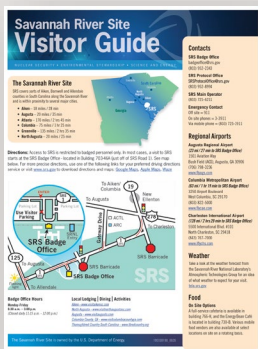

Important Steps

- Register your visit in advance using the [OneNNSAccess portal](https://public.srs.gov/visitors-and-tours/#onennsaccess).
- Contact your SRS host or sponsor to determine if your visit requires site-specific safety training or enhanced access control authorizations.
- Bring your HSPD-12 badge with you.
- Ensure your badge remains visible and worn at all times while on-site.
